There are two disciplines used to evaluate handwriting.

The Forensic examination: scientifically, to determine authorship.

The second from a profiling aspect, looking at the personality traits to determine the author's state of mind at the time of writing.

Most of the work I receive has to do with the forensic document examination, but I am trained in both disciplines

Looking at the first and second letters, strictly from a Forensic application, it is highly probable that both letters were written by the same author.

The absence of the originals, effects the number personality traits that can be determined from the handwriting / printing.

Here are some of the details I can deduce from the samples I received.

The Author appears to be of average intelligence and focused, with emotional responsiveness in the midrange controlled both by head and heart.

There is evidence of motor skill problems, possible neurological damage.

They are able to pay attention to the details that are deemed important to them.

The author is keeping their anger under control, but will get more progressively involved with a project as time goes on.
